The Research on Adaptation after Migration into Underpopulated Mountainous Regions

1. Research background and purpose

In recent years, in the countryside of Japan, population decrease and aging problems are! more and more serious. And the villages are reducing, and in this way, may disappear in the future. The Chinese settler, Ms. K lives with her husband and parents in the traditional village in Japan. The life after emigration is so different from her life that she met a lot of trouble there.

3. Investigation results

As a Chinese lady, though meeting lots of problems in language and culture, Ms. K permeated into the village favorably, owe to the natives' enthusiasm, her families' help and her own efforts. And there are still some problems of the adaptation to local life, since there are few young people living there, and sometimes loneliness exists.

As the foreigner, Ms. K adapted to the life in the villages. She was approbatory in the family and the village. And her affairs also prove that, as a settler, the emigration resolution is necessary in the setting and adapting phases.
