### ■ Bus/Subway transportation to "Miyako-messe" Hall

Please come to "Miyako-messe" by public transportation, not by car since there is no parking space.

<By Subway>	8 minutes walk from Higashiyama Sta. on the Touzai Line.
<By Bus>	
From Kyoto Sta.	#5/#100: Get off at "Kyoto-kaikan or Bijutsukan-mae" (京都会館・美術館前) #206: Get off at "Higashiyama Nijo" (東山二条)
From Shijo-Kawaramachi	#5/#32/#46: Get off at "Kyoto-kaikan or Bijutsukan-mae" (京都会館・美術館前) #31/#201/#203: Get off at "Higashiyama Nijo" (東山二条)
From Sanjo-Keihan	#5: Get off at "Kyoto-kaikan or Bijutsukan-mae" (京都会館・美術館前)

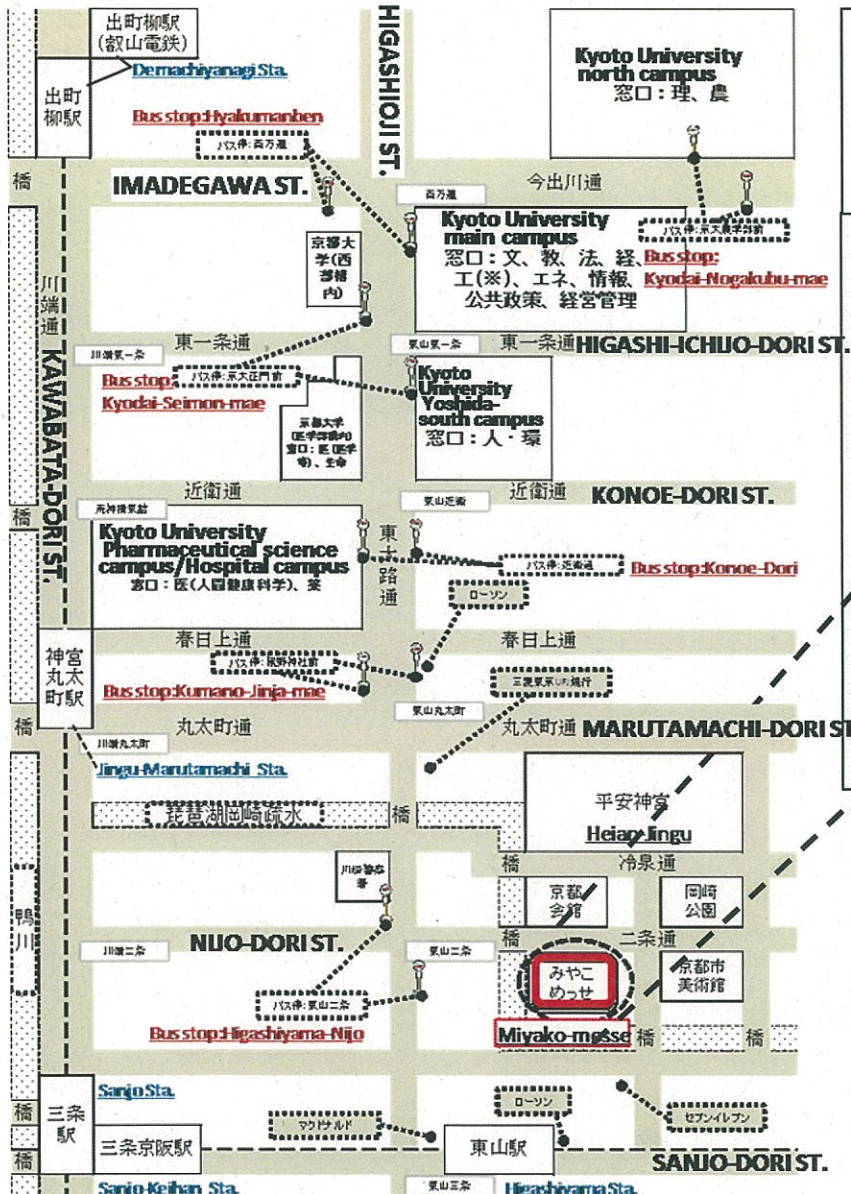
### ■ Bus transportation from Kyoto University main campus to "Miyako-messe" hall

It will take 20~30 minutes to go to "Miyako-messe" from Kyoto University by walk.

In case using bus from Kyoto University, take the following bus #31, #201 or #206.

The nearest bus stop from "Miyako-messe" is "Higashiyama Nijo" (東山二条). The nearest bus stops from Kyoto University are "Konoe-Dori" (近衛通), "Kyodai Seimon-Mae" (京大正門前) or "Hyakumanben" (百万遍).

If you will take a bus at "Kyodai Nogakubu-Mae" (京大農学部前), take #203 bus to go to "Miyako-messe".
