Eligibility Requirements

Applicants wishing to apply through General Admission (including career-track and thesis-track admissions) must satisfy ONE of the following requirements.

- 1) You must have completed or intend to complete a master's degree program at a Japanese university by September 30, 2021 (for enrollment in October 2021) or by March 31, 20212022 (for enrollment in April 1, 2022).
- 2) You must have completed or intend to complete a master's degree program at a university outside Japan by September 30, 2021 (for enrollment in October 2021) or by March 31, 20212022 (for enrollment in April 1, 2022).
- 3) Alternative qualifications equivalent to the above.
